For all The Chandlery Candle Bar workshops, candle making, or classes.

Candle Bar Waiver:

I hereby agree to release, waive, discharge, hold harmless, defend and indemnify The Chandlery Candle Bar, its managers, members, and employees from all liability, including financial responsibility, from any and all claims, actions or losses for personal injuries or damages of any kind that may arise from my participation in a candle bar visit, workshop, event, class, resulting products, or from use of equipment provided by The Chandlery Candle Bar.

I agree to hold The Chandlery Candle Bar entirely free from any liability for any injuries incurred on or off the premises of The Chandlery Candle Bar.

I also acknowledge the risks involved in participating in a candle-making activity. These include, but are not limited to, bodily injury, property damage, or wrongful death.

I swear that I am participating voluntarily. Additionally, I do not have any conditions that will increase my likelihood of experiencing injuries while engaging in this activity. I will make every effort to obey safety precautions as explained to me verbally. I will ask for clarification when needed.

I also agree that I will not use any items created here for promotion of any other business that operates in the same capacity as The Chandlery Candle Bar.

LIABILITY WAIVER

For All Candle Refills

REFILL, RECYCLE, REDUCE YOUR WASTE

Once you are finished with your candle from The Chandlery Candle Bar, you can refill and reuse the same container!

- 1 You may return your cleaned out candle containers to have them refilled with your favorite fragrances. Refilling takes about two weeks and you can drop off your containers or ship it back to The Chandlery Candle Bar.
- 2 Sign up for a Refill Class and create your own fragrance combination!

Preparing Your Vessel for Candle Refill Class:

- 1. Warm the empty candle glass/wood to melt the residual wax.
- 2. Use a paper towel to gently remove the wax and metal wick holder from the bottom of the vessel.
- 3. Once the wax is removed from a glass vessel, remove any final residue using warm soapy water and another paper towel to gently wipe. Do not use water on a wooden vessel. Instead, use a hair dryer to melt and remove all residual wax.
- 4. Dry the vessel and inspect for any hairline cracks or chips. If found, do not refill and instead check out other ways to reuse your vessel.
- 5. Vessel must be clean and ready for use.

WARNING:

I understand it is my responsibility to inspect and ensure my glass or wooden vessel is free of cracks, hairline fractures, or any damage. I understand I cannot reuse the the vessel if it is not in good candle condition. I also understand that reusing a damaged vessel may cause the candle to leak hot wax, crack, shatter, or explode which may cause bodily harm, injury, or fire. Damage may occur to surfaces and area surrounding the candle. I release The Chandlery Candle Bar from any liability should a problem arise after I refill my glass or wooden vessel or have it refilled with new wax.

I have inspected the vessel for any compromising defects like cracks and I accept full liability for my vessel and forfeit all rights to bring a suit against The Chandlery Candle Bar for any reason.
